

SEEDINVEST Program

The SEEDINVEST Program is dedicated to empowering MSMEs by providing them with asset grants for their businesses. Since 2019, we have supported over 80 entrepreneurs across Nigeria with equipment for their businesses. This asset support has had varied impacts on the supported businesses, which includes growth, efficient and effective production process and employing more staff to meet increased demand.





Education

Our **Campus Kit Program** was launched late 2021 with a focus on supporting students in public tertiary institutions across Nigeria. The program is three-pronged and includes the:


i. School Fees Intervention Scheme (SFIS)

The scheme provides school fees support to qualified, privileged students of public tertiary institutions in Nigeria. We have paid fees for 7 students in 2021.

ii. Undergraduate Entrepreneurship Incubation Program (UEIP)

This supports existing student entrepreneurs with unique business models with asset grants to drive their businesses.

The maiden cycle of the program held in the first half of 2022 and 4 student entrepreneurs got asset grants for their businesses.

iii. Digital and Tech Development Skills (DTDS)

With this, we aim to provide undergraduate students with opportunities to acquire digital/tech skills outside of their course syllabi. This is fused with the UEIP.



Health

HealthWize Program

HealthWize is focused on providing affordable healthcare to underserved persons. We have an ongoing partnership with **Crimson Bow Sickle Cell Initiative,** a sickle cell organisation, to provide medications for patients who attend their monthly sickle cell clinics. The average number of attendees at these clinics range between 50 and 57 monthly.





Other Interventions

Our interventions are however not limited to the above. In our over two years of operation, we have:

- Donated food supplies to over 2,000 families in Lagos State during the COVID-19 lockdown in 2020,
- Provided a borehole water facility to Arrows of God Orphanage in Lagos,
- supported the creative arts sector,
- Provided 8 interested women with the opportunity to acquire tech skills.




